

World/European Rules for Sports Clothing

Article 01 – General

Sportsmen/women who are participating in international competitions have to leave a clean and elegant impression.

The sports clothing is determined by the responsible national federation. It has to fulfil the given specifications of the UMB/CEB and has to be the same for all sportsmen/women of one country, whatever the kind of the championship is. At championships and at official tournaments with free inscription the uniformity is only valid for those sportsmen/women who are inscribed through their national federation.

Concerning teams all sportsmen/women have to wear exactly the same clothes.

The badge of their federation has to be worn by the sportsmen/women on the left side of the chest.

Article 02 – Sports Clothing

Regulations: waistcoat, black trousers, black shoes, black socks, bow-tie, one-coloured long-sleeved shirt. Jeans and cord-pants are not authorized.

Article 03 – Advertising

The advertising on man/woman is laid down the european rules for publicity (WRA/ERA).

Article 04 – Application

These rules are valid for male sportsmen and juniors.

For female sportswomen the same rules are applicable with the following exceptions: long-sleeved one-coloured shirt or one-coloured blouse which is closed at the neck. Waistcoat and bow-tie **are not** compulsory.

Article 05 – Coming into Force

These regulations are coming into force with the playing season 2006/07.
